

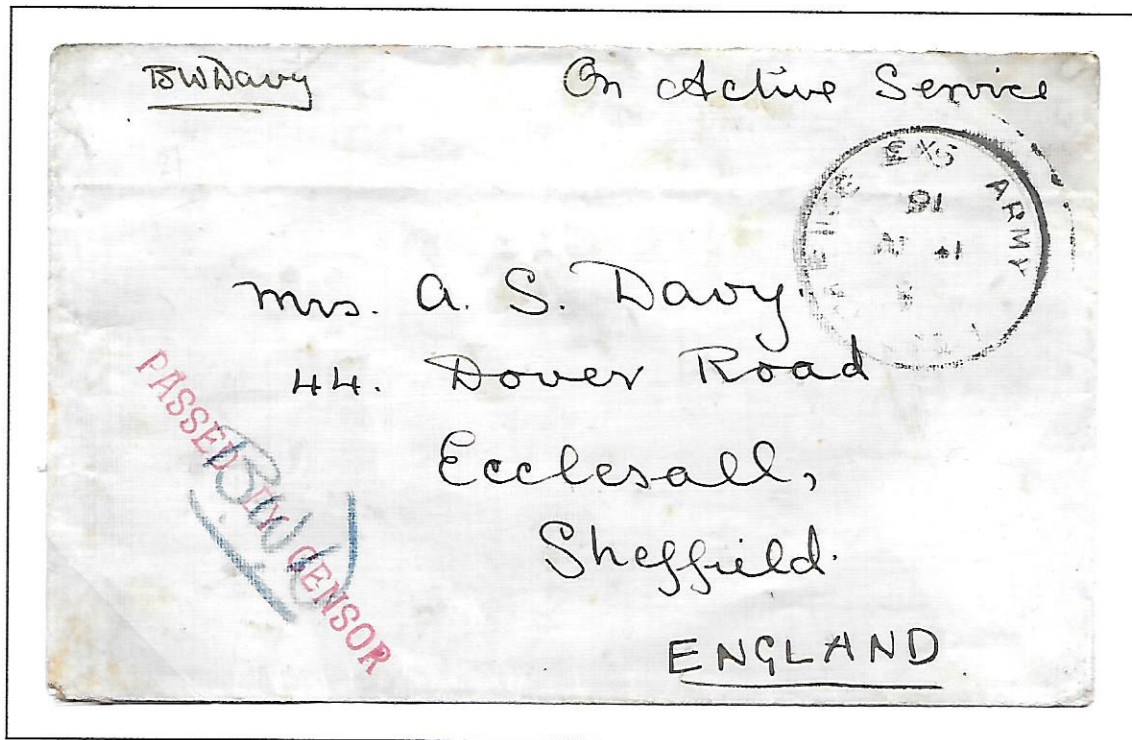

On a 1916 envelope Midshipman B.W. Davy, writes to his mother in Sheffield, postmarked Army Post Office, SX3 (Mudros), the date is unclear, censor mark Gould 4C349 (Mudros) is present. On 10<sup>th</sup> July 1916 he was killed along with his pilot Ft/Lt. V. Nicholson, RNAS, when their aircraft a Short Type C Tractor Biplane Seaplane crashed near Ispatho Island off Imbros. Both he and his pilot are buried side by side in the Lancashire Landing Cemetery on Gallipoli, it is believed that many isolated graves on Imbros were relocated to this location after the end of the war.
