

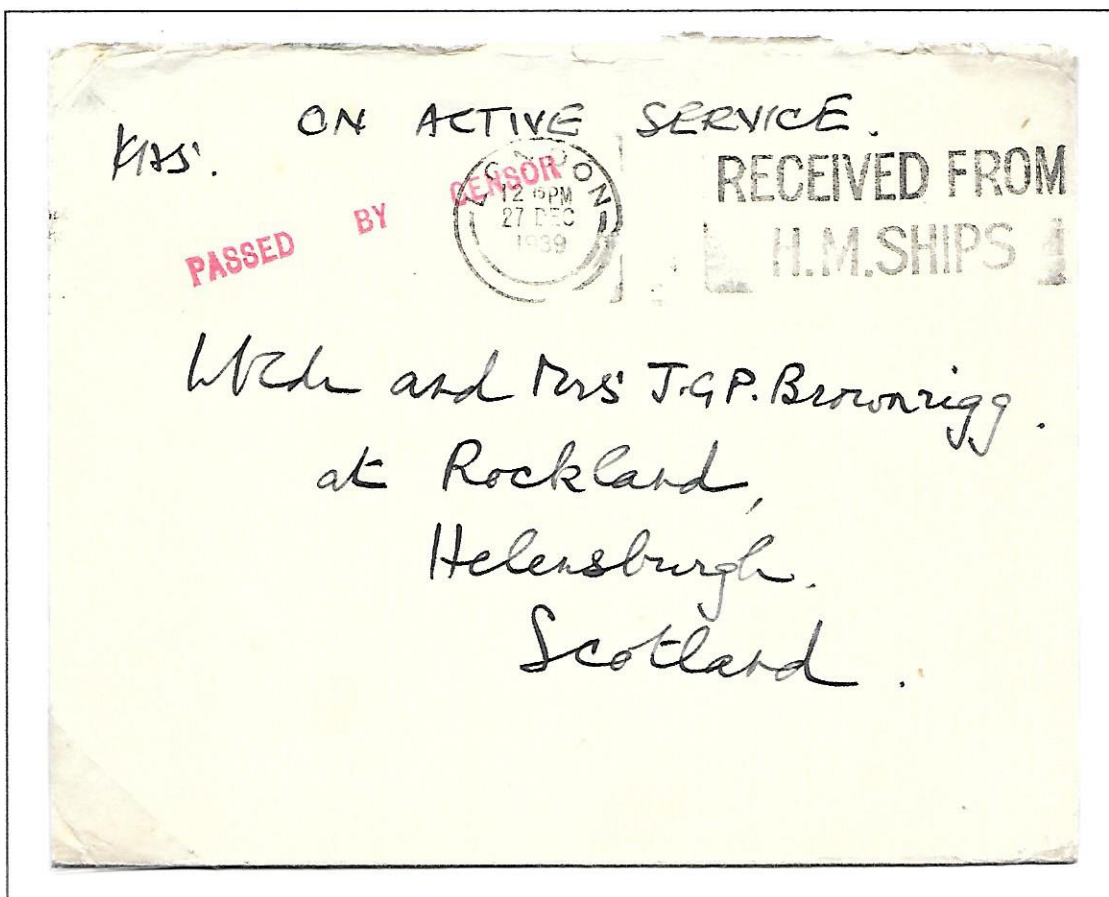

Envelope postmarked 27th December 1939, addressed to Lieut Commander and Mrs J.G.P. Brownrigg at their home in Helensburgh, Scotland. Lt/Cdr Brownrigg lost his life, age 37 when the Battlecruiser H.M.S. Hood was blown up and sunk by the German Battleship Bismarck in the Denmark Strait on 24th May 1941, with the loss of over 1400 lives, there were only three survivors.
