The type IV and V handstamps are usually found on unexamined mails.

Type IVA Half moon containing CENSOR. This is a broad categorisation as there are many variations and sub types, but due to over and underinking and poorly struck marks, it is virtually impossible to classify.

Type IVBa Pentagon containing CENSOR. As above minor variations have been noted. Struck in violet or blue.

Type IVBb As IVBa but much larger and has been included as sub-type.

✓ **Type VA** Half moon with blank centre.

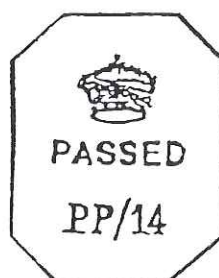
Type VB Pentagon with a blank centre, struck in mauve.

Type VC Triangle with blank centre.
Both types VA and VB in red, violet, black and blue-black.

The numbered handstamps are thought to have been applied at Lagos except No. 14 P Harcourt, No. 21 Kano and possibly No. 13 at Kaduna.
